Estate-grown, well-balanced and beautifully textured wine full of plush ripe dark berries and sweet vanilla with an interesting herbal edge.

2008 Le Casque “Adrian” Red Wine *(Lincoln, CA)*

“On the nose the Mourvedre dominates the blend with strong notes of dark fruits, forest floor and red meats. These continue in the mouth where the Grenache adds flavors of cherry and spice. All of this is framed by toasty new oak and firm tannins which linger on the long finish.”

2009 Morgan “Twelve Clones” Pinot Noir *(Santa Lucia Highlands)*

From the best of the best vineyards...“*Double L, Tondre Grapefield, Rosella's.*” Aromas of pomegranate, cherry cola, strawberry jam with a hint of spice. Flavors of black cherry and chocolate are complemented by notes of black tea and spices. Perfectly poised fruit/acid balance make this incredibly food-versatile.

2008 Stemmler Pinot Noir *(Carneros)*

93 Points “Wine Spectator” ---“Wonderfully aromatic, showing smoke, mahogany and sandalwood notes that carry through all the way through the finish. Smooth, rich flavors of black cherry, boysenberry and wild strawberry are expressive, concentrated and refined.”

2007 Tofanelli Zinfandel *(Napa Valley)*

A bold, full-bodied wine with vibrant aromas of blackberry, black pepper, smokey oak and vanilla. On the palate lush flavors of ripe, red cherry, cranberry, cracked black pepper. Lingering blackberries and spice with subtle tannins come out during long finish!

2009 Mettler Petite Sirah *(Lodi)*

The flavors are bold, ripe and fleshy, delivering a core of concentrated dark berries, framboise, maple and tobacco with ending notes of anise and warm spices. The mouth-feel is dense and extracted with supple tannins, while the flavors gently glide through a long finish. There is a dark, juicy and deliciously flavored mouthful of Petite Sirah.

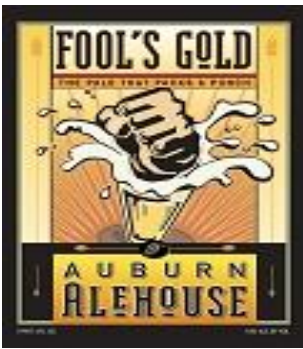

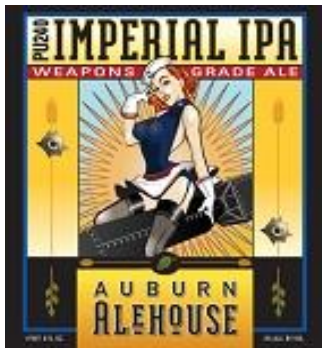

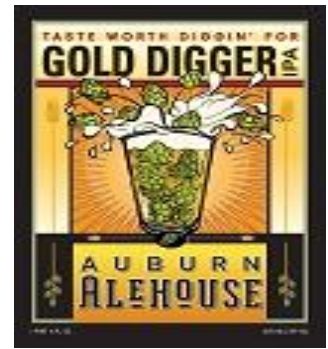
